Saturday Morning Science Program for students in grades 3-6.

### ***What is the Saturday Science Program?***

The Saturday Morning Science Program provides children in grades 3 through 6 with hands-on experiences and explorations in science, engineering, and environmental topics. There will be four two-hour sessions. Sessions will be held on the Emmanuel College campus.

### ***What curriculum is available?***

Participating students will receive exemplary science kits and materials designed by scientists, engineers and environmental educators. The materials are intended for use in informal settings and after-school science programs.

### ***Who is eligible?***

We encourage applications from all Emmanuel College students in all departments. No prior teaching experience is necessary and students are not required to be an Education major.

### ***How will students be supported?***

Emmanuel students will work in teams of between 2 and 4. Each team will work with up to ten children in grades 3-6. Teams will be advised by Emmanuel College Science and Education faculty.

### ***What is the time commitment?***

There will be four two-hour sessions. The Saturday Science Program is scheduled for **9 am to 11am** on alternate Saturdays in March and April (3/19, 4/2, 4/16, 4/30).

### ***What are the benefits?***

Students will receive a certificate of recognition to be awarded May 2011.
