What is the Science Ambassador Program?

The Science Ambassador Program partners Emmanuel College science majors with a neighborhood K-8 school that serves a high proportion of students who are underrepresented in the science fields. Science Ambassadors assist science teachers in the school by organizing and preparing hands-on materials, finding creative and interesting ways of engaging students in science, and being a facilitator in class discussions and science demonstrations. Science Ambassadors serve as mentors for youth in the community.

What schools do Science Ambassadors serve?

Science Ambassadors are assigned to local k-8 schools that serve a high proportion of students who are underrepresented in the science fields.

What is the time commitment?

Students will make 3 to 4 visits to a k-8 school.

How many Science Ambassadors will be selected?

Four Science Ambassadors will be selected in spring 2011

Who is eligible?

The Science Ambassador Program is open to Emmanuel College science majors of advanced standing (e.g., juniors or seniors).

What are the benefits?

Science Ambassadors will receive a certificate of recognition to be awarded May 2011.
